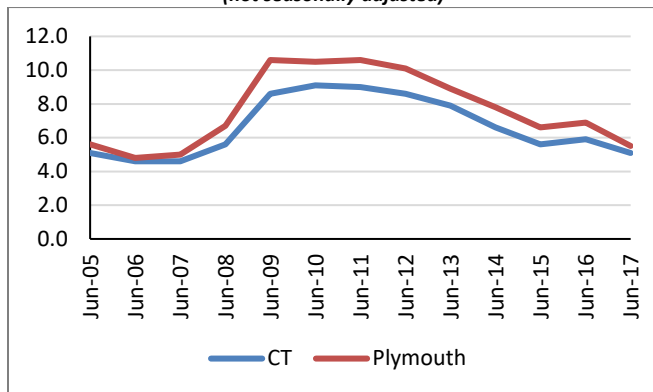

Unemployment Rates And Median Household Income

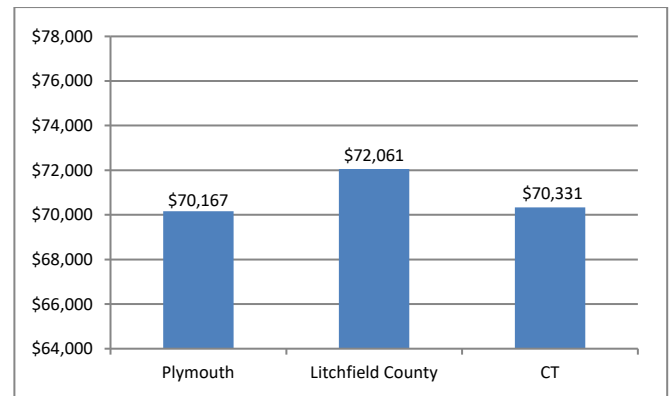
**Unemployment Rate

Over the past twelve years, from 2005 to 2017, the unemployment rate in Plymouth has been consistently about one to two percentage points higher than that of the state; it also trended as one of the highest in North Central Connecticut through the recession.
