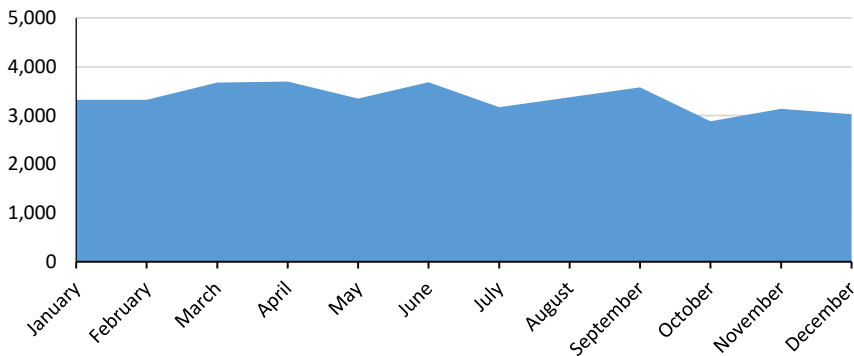
## Healthcare Industry Workers by Age

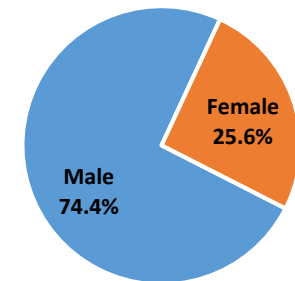

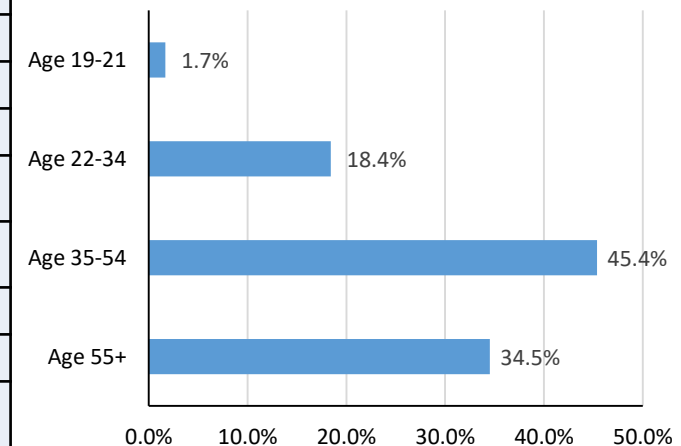

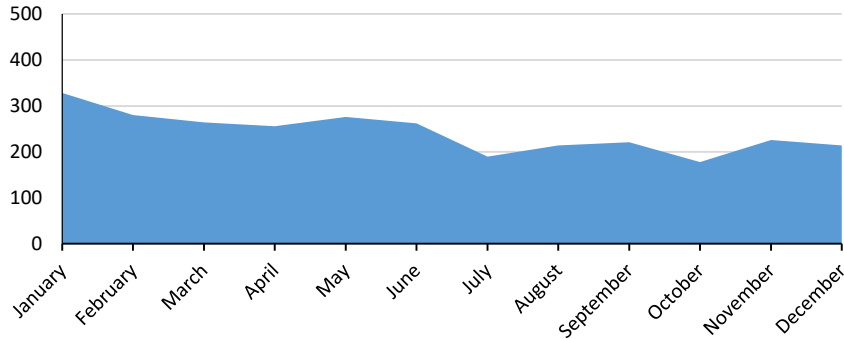
## Manufacturing Industry Workers by Age

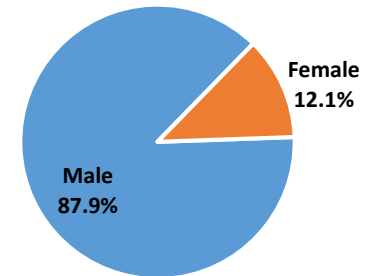

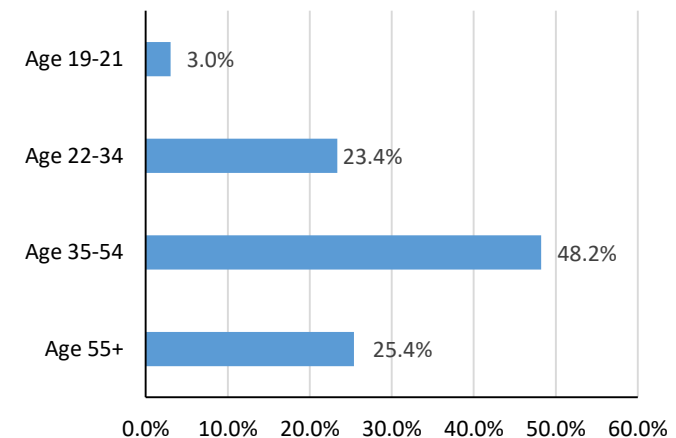

## Construction Industry Workers by Gender



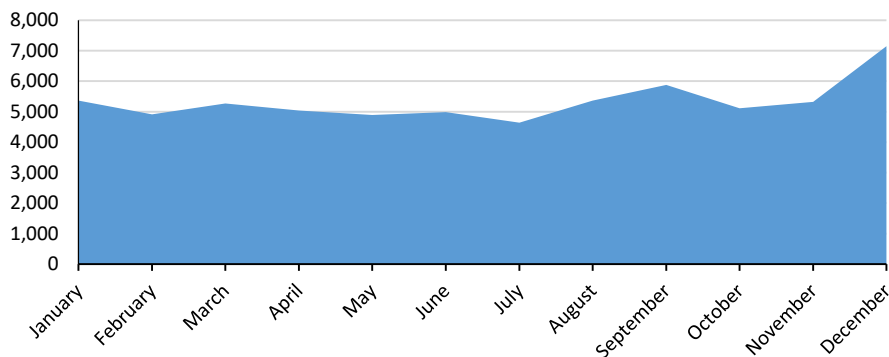
## Construction Industry Workers by Age

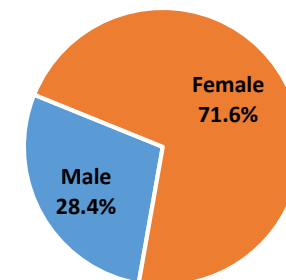
