IMPORTANT MESSAGE ABOUT SN



If you are a SNAP recipient in Connecticut you must report

- When your household's total monthly gross income exceeds 130% of the federal poverty level (FPL), and
- If you or a member of your household is subject to time-limited SNAP and work fewer than 80 hours in a month.

130% of FPL depends on the number of people in your household

Report if your income is over
\$1,316
\$1,784
\$2,252
\$2,720
\$3,188
\$3,656
\$4,124
\$4,592

Each additional household member \$468

Gross income is the amount before any deduction.

Total household income includes all earned and unearned income of each household member.

WHEN?

You must report these changes by the 10th day of the month following the month of the change your household's circumstances.
