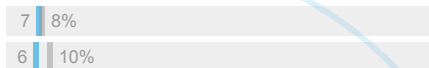

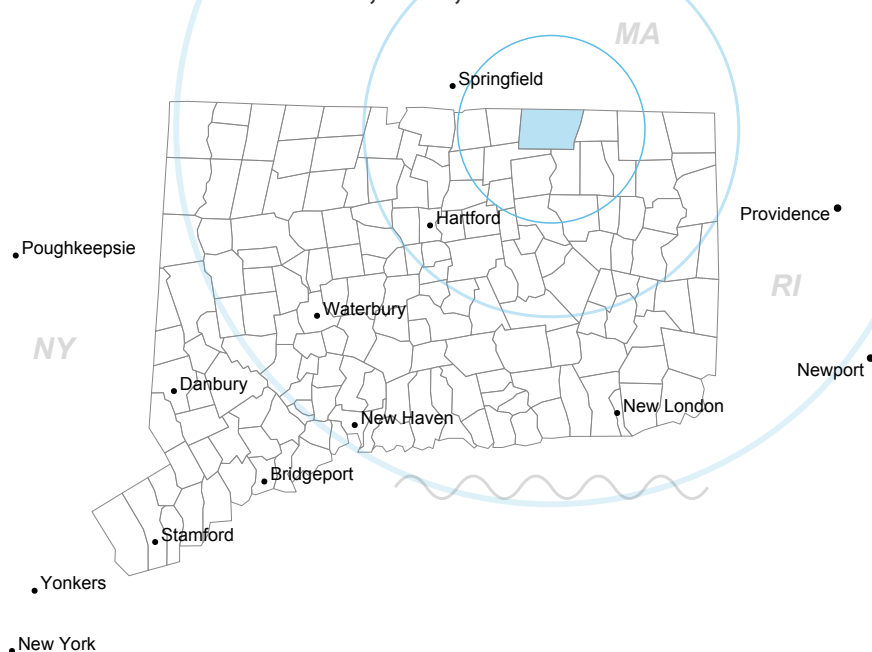
Unemployment Rate

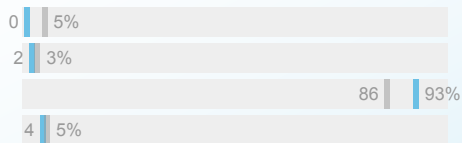
