- Develop and sustain strategic partnerships with manufacturing sector stakeholders including employers, training providers, and industry associations, facilitating access to workforce programs and resources.
- Introduce employers to the workforce development system in North-Central Connecticut and create business service plans to support their hiring and training priorities.
- Implement business services including recruitment events, on-the-job training (OJT), incumbent worker training (IWT), subsidized employment, and job placement activities as needed to support CWP IT initiatives.
- Develop job leads that match participant qualifications, screen candidates, and make appropriate employer referrals.
- Consult with strategy team to ensure grant applications and program designs are aligned with employer needs.
- Serve as regional subject matter expert on workforce issues in the manufacturing sector, maintaining knowledge of major employers, labor market information, career pathways, and training programs.
- Use ETO and other software to track business contacts, services, and activities.
- Provide technical assistance to staff pertaining to business and job seeker

- issues in manufacturing.
- Respond to grant requirements and compliance regarding timely completion of deliverables.
- Represent CWP at a variety of public forums, business and community events, and conferences.
- Work as an integral part of the Business Engagement team.
